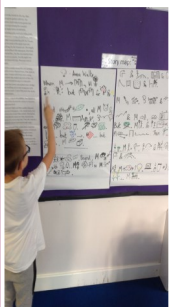
Seacole Class

Thunberg Class

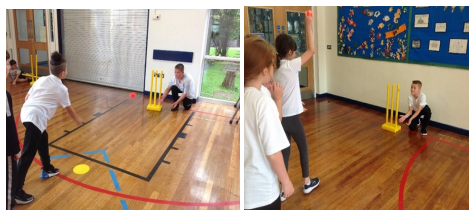
This week, Thunberg have been working hard to learn our model text, **Florette by Anna Walker**. We have practiced retelling it using our story maps.

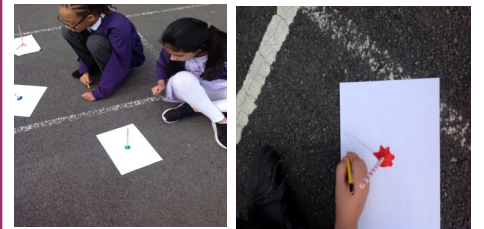
Malala Class
