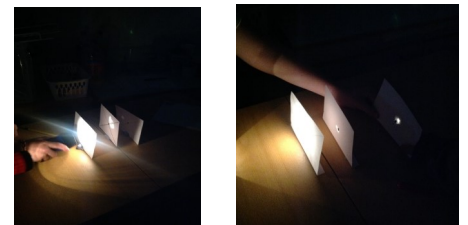
Malala Class
