Moore Class

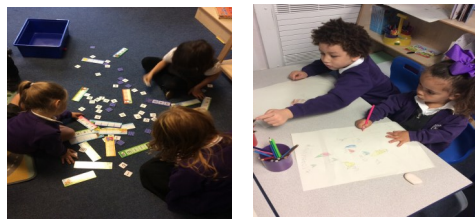
This week the children have been learning and talking about different cultures.

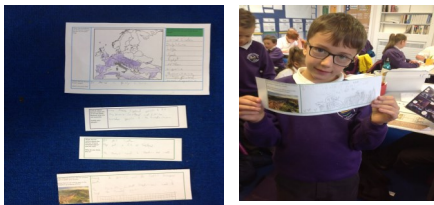
Seacole Class

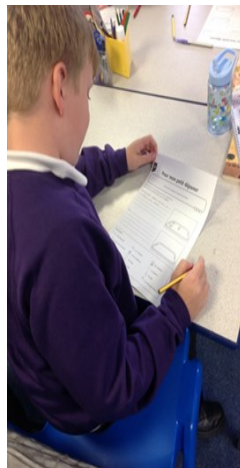
Thunberg Class
