We will be delivering these to elderly people in our community next week.

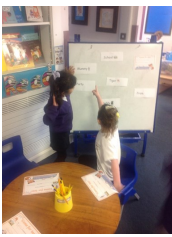
Don't forget, next week is parents' evening, Halloween Disco and school closes for half term on Thursday.

Moore Class

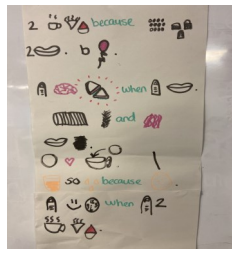
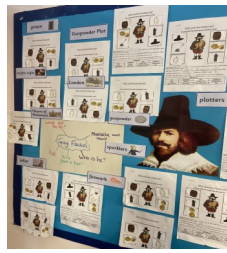
This week the children in Moore class have been preparing for their Tiger Tea party. As a class they discussed what was needed to plan and host a tea party.
