
Malala Class

This week, Rashford, have been writing non-fiction reports all about COVID-19. As this is something we are all really similar with, it has produced some brilliant information texts.




In maths, we have been focusing on the formal written methods for addition and subtraction. Rashford, you have had a super first half term to Year 6 - keep up the hard work.


Dates for the Diary

Class Attendance Figures


Each class target is 97% attendance!
