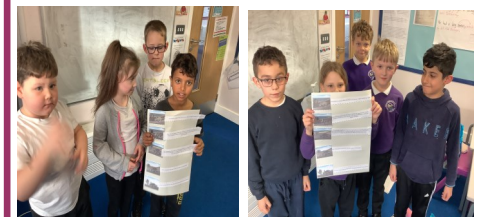

Malala Class

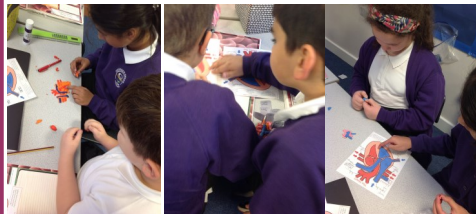
This week in DT we made our own apple crumble. We really enjoyed rubbing together the flour and butter and we liked peeling and chopping the apples!
