This week in Moore class we have been learning about making healthy choices and have made fruit kebabs. We have learnt how to use tools safely when chopping and peeling the fruits.



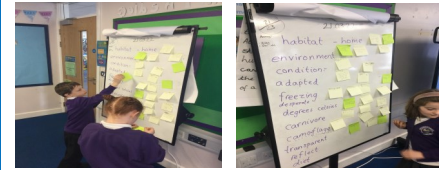
### Simmonds Class

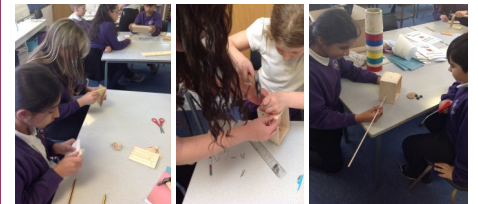
### Malala Class
