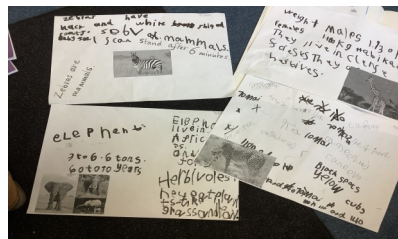
Moore Class

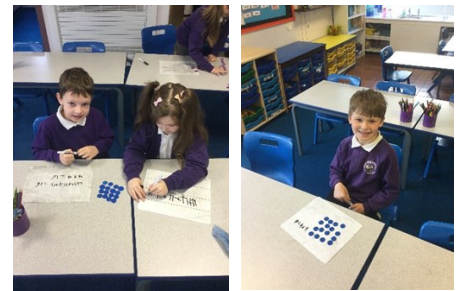
Simmonds Class

Thunberg Class

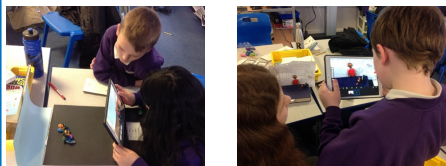
