This week in Simmonds class we have been looking at making half and a quarter. We have done this using shapes, colouring and using a ruler to help us find half/quarter.

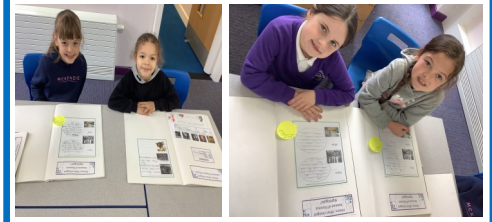
We then went on to look at how to find a half and a quarter of numerals/quantities and on Friday, we used our skills to create and half/quarter pizzas!

Mr Raj will put them on class dojo so you can have a look at them and challenge yourself to answering the questions!

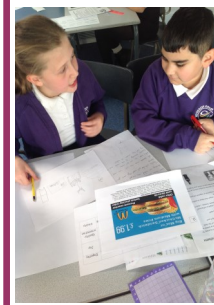
Malala Class

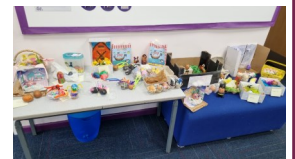
