

A message from the Head Teacher

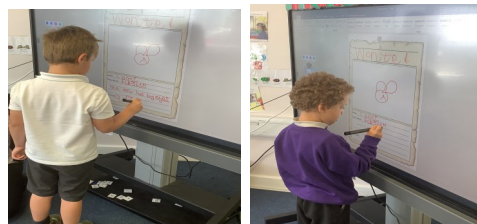

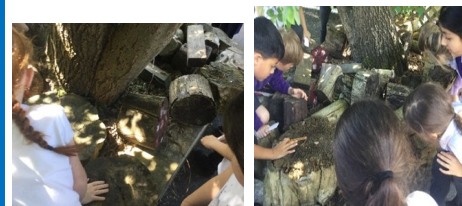
Simmonds Class

As sad as that was, we wish her all the best at her new school, starting in September.

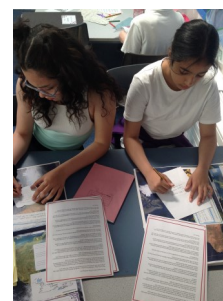
Malala Class
