Thunberg Class

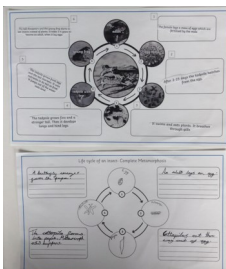
Thunberg have been working hard becoming familiar with our discussion text in English. We have been working on complex sentences, connectives and tense.
