Seacole class have been exploring measuring in length and were asked to measure certain body parts and order them shortest to longest. They have been learning how to use a ruler correctly and what

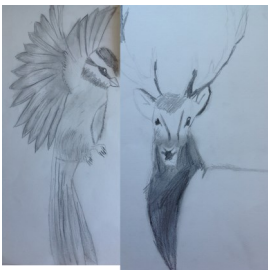


happens if a line is not straight.

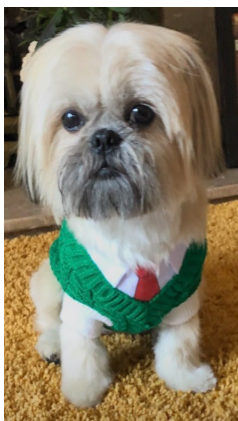
Meet Ella our Pets as Therapy dog
