### Seacole Class

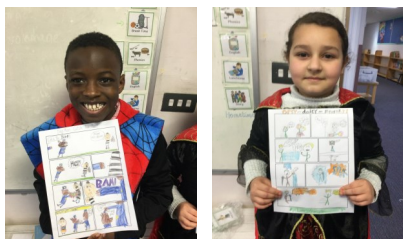

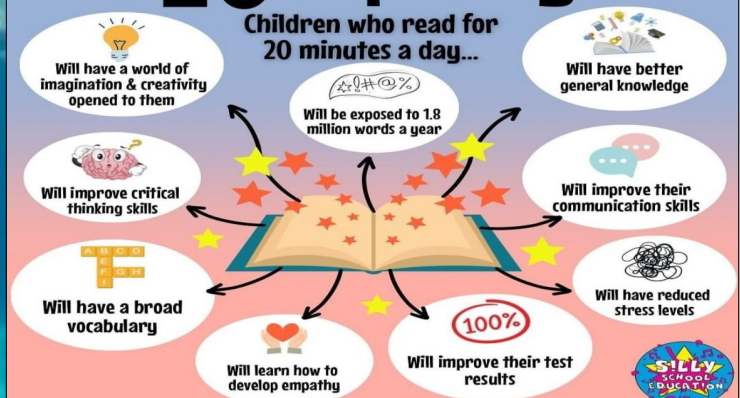
