Dear Parent/Carer,

We hope to maintain regular contact with parents to share activities and work that will help keep your children's minds and bodies active, and keep them learning whilst schools are closed for most children. Our aim is to set tasks that are not too onerous on parents, which children can access and vary across the breadth of curriculum.

As schools are still open for key workers and for children with an EHCP, work for those children at home will now be set **weekly** via class Dojo. As 'work packs' have already been sent home or remain in school for you to collect, the 'online' work will begin from 9:30am on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> March 2020, and will be updated weekly. We will send home a link to our **Home School Plans**, for children in each year group that will summarise your children's curriculum plan so that parents/carers can briefly understand what subjects your children have covered this academic year at school, and those that they would normally be covering between Easter and July 2020. This guide will give helpful links to online resources and websites that you might find useful for children continuing their learning whilst they are at home. Any work, such as maths that you may need answers for, with a link on our school website weekly.
